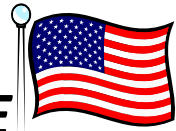


WASHINGTON STATE GRANGE QUILTS FOR THE BRAVE



Our Quilts for the Brave program provides quilts to our injured service men and women returning to the United States from our war zones around the world.

Please make these quilts lap size – approximately 45 inches by 60 inches. A size that would cover an individual in a wheel chair or resting in a recuperation center.

It is important that you use 100 percent cotton for this project. Red, white and blue colors are very appropriate.

Along with this program is a need for Passage/Bereavement Quilts to be used at our Veteran's hospitals throughout the State of Washington for our brave military men and women who have passed on.

These quilts are placed on the body as it is removed from the hospital to the waiting vehicle. Some quilts may then be presented to the family of the veteran while some are returned to the hospital and after an appropriate time, may be used for another Veteran that has gone on. These quilts must be red, white and blue and be at least a twin bed size. again, cotton is the preferred material.

Your efforts, in the continuation of this very special program, are greatly appreciated.
