

NEEDLEWORK CONTEST – 2009

WHAT TO ENTER

GROUP I - Crochet, Knit, Tat (Cotton crochet threads)

Class A: Something for the House
(bedspreads, tablecloths, doilies,
centerpieces or table toppers)

GROUP II - Knit, Crochet (Synthetic, blended, or natural yarns)

Class B: Afghans

Class C: Baby Afghans. Must follow a baby theme.

Class D: 3-Piece Baby Set. To include cap and sweater with choice of booties or Afghan

Class E: Something to Wear

GROUP III - Embroidery and Stitchery (Floss or yarns in combination or alone)

Class F: Hand Embroidery – Table/Luncheon Cloths, Pillowcases/Dresser Scarf.

Class G: Counted Cross Stitch – any item

Class H: Needlepoint/Plastic Canvas - any item

GROUP IV - Other

Class I: Other. Any other needlework not included in other categories, i.e. latch hook, ribbon embroidery, etc.

GROUP V - Any Needlework Technique using above guidelines and submitting any item including Latch Hook.

Class J: Teens 14-19 years – any item

Class K: Boys and Girls 13 years and under – any item

ELIGIBILITY

Grange members and non-members may enter. All work must be that of the contestant and completed within the contest year. The underside of all entries must be visible. A person may submit any number of entries on the subordinate/Pomona level but all must be entered through one subordinate Grange. Only one entry per person per class will be allowed for state judging. Contestants must abide by the judges decision, contest rules, and their interpretation.

JUDGING

All entries will be judged on workmanship, general appearance, design selection, color harmony, and suitability to purpose.

AWARDS

Awards at the Pomona judging are the responsibility of the Pomona Grange State awards in each class are: First place \$20, Second place \$15, Third place \$10; except Group V which is First \$12, Second \$11, Third \$10.

ENTRY FORM

Complete general CWA entry form. Fold bottom portion upward on fold like and pin with safety pin (no straight pins) so that only group and class are visible. Place entry form in a sandwich size zip-lock bag and pin to lower left corner of item.
