

QUILTING CONTEST - 2009

WHAT TO ENTER

- Class A: Large Quilts (King/Queen Size)
80 inches by 125 inches minimum and maximum.
- Class B: Small Quilts (Double/Twin Size)
60 inches by 102 inches minimum and maximum.
- Class C: Tied Comforter
60 inches by 125 inches minimum and maximum.
- Class D: Wall Hanging
18 inches minimum by 60 inches minimum and maximum
- Class E: Baby or Lap Quilts
36 inches by 60 inches minimum and maximum
- Class F: Baby & Lap Tied Comforters
36 by 60 inches minimum and maximum.
- Class G: Other (place mats, pillows, etc.)
Any quilted item that doesn't fit into other classes.
- Class H: Teens 14-19 years.
Any quilted item.
- Class I: Boys & Girls 13 years and under.
Any quilted item.

For the purpose of this contest, quilts are composed of a top fabric, batting, and a backing fabric stitched together with quilting stitches.

Comforters are a thick extra loft bating between two layers of fabric held together by tying.

ELIGIBILITY

Grange members and non-members may enter.

No pre-cut quilt kits, no pre-printed quilt panels.

Baby quilt must have baby theme.

All classes can be either hand- or machine-quilted except Class C & F which must be tied.

Any pattern or design may be used.

Any commercial batting can be used.

All entries must be completed in the current year.

A person may submit any number of entries on the Subordinate/Pomona level, but all must be entered through one subordinate Grange.

Only one entry per person per class will be allowed for state judging.

Contestant must abide by the judges decision, contest rules, and their interpretation.

JUDGING

All entries will be judged on general appearance, design, and workmanship.

AWARDS

State awards in each class are: First place \$20, Second place \$15, Third place \$10, except Classes H and I which are First place \$12, Second place \$11, Third place \$10.

ENTRY FORM

Complete general CWA entry form. Fold bottom portion upward on fold like and pin with safety pin (no straight pins) so that only group and class are visible. Place entry form in a sandwich size zip-lock bag and pin to lower left corner of item.
