

**WASHINGTON STATE GRANGE**  
**ARTS & CRAFTS CONTEST – 2011**

1. This contest is open to both Grange members and non-members. Non-members must be sponsored by a subordinate Grange.
2. All work must be the work of the exhibitor. Entries must have been completed after May 15 (or Pomona judging date) of the previous year.
3. Participants may have more than one entry per class.
4. Exhibitor must assure that their entry is entered in the correct class.
5. Soiled items will not be accepted.
6. All entries will be judged. Any entry deemed inappropriate by the person in charge of the contest may not be displayed.
7. Any entry that is intended to be hung must be ready for hanging with the appropriate hanging device attached.
8. Age of youth and junior contestants will be as of January 1 of the current year.
9. All entries will be judged at the Pomona level. The highest scoring entry in each class at the Pomona contest should receive a purple ribbon and forwarded on to the state contest, to be held at the State Grange Convention in June. The Pomona Lecturer has the option of bypassing this rule if only one entry is received at the Pomona level and that entry is deemed to be of inferior quality.
10. Contestants at the state level must be responsible for bringing their items to the state convention and picking them up at the designated time.
11. Valuable items should be adequately insured by their owners before being sent to the state convention. The State Grange assumes no liability for loss or damage to entries.
12. The back of needlework entries may be closed. In crafts, we judge the finished project.
13. Judging in the craft contest will be based on: Workmanship (good quality, technique, neat); Conformation (good color, shape); and Appearance of Display.
14. Awards: Pomona contest awards are the responsibility of the Pomona Grange. All entries should be awarded ribbons - purple, blue, red, white, or green. State contest awards will be awarded by the State Grange Lecturer Department. Ribbons will be awarded to all entries. Rosettes will be awarded to the top entry in each class.
15. The Best of Show entry in each Group A-I will receive \$50 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Best of Show in the same groups will receive \$25.
16. The Best of Show entry in each Group J-K will receive \$25 and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Best of Show in the same groups will receive \$15.
