

WASHINGTON STATE GRANGE PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST – 2011

1. This contest is open to both Grange members and non-members. Non-members must be sponsored by a subordinate Grange. Receiving compensation of any kind does not prohibit a member from taking part in the contest.
2. The photographer must select the class for his/her entry.
3. A print may be entered in only one class.
4. Participants may enter all classes using separate prints.
5. Participants may have more than one entry per class. This will allow for a bigger and better photography contest at the Pomona level.
6. Entries must have been completed after May 15 (or the Pomona judging date) of the previous year.
7. Prints may be made by a commercial processor, but must have been taken by the entrant.
8. Matting and backing with matte board is required for all photos. There must be a minimum 1” mat margin on all sides. And a maximum mat margin of 2 ½” on all sides. Please be sure the photo is securely attached. **NO FRAMES OR COVERINGS OF ANY TYPE.**
9. Photos must be one of the following standard sizes: 5”x7”, 8”x10”, 8”x12”, or 5”x14”. Photos not these exact sizes will be disqualified.
10. The Pomona Lecturer has the authority to adjust the rules as necessary for the Pomona Contest.
11. Title is optional.
12. Age of contestants in the youth and children’s groups will be as of January 1 of the current year.
13. All entries will be judged at the Pomona level. The highest scoring entry in each class should receive a purple ribbon and be forwarded to the state contest, held during the State Grange Convention in June.
14. Judging in the photography contest will be based on: composition and arrangement, interest, presentation, technique, and appropriateness for category entered.
15. All entries will be awarded ribbons. Rosettes will be awarded at the state level to the highest placing entry in each class.
16. One entry will be selected to represent WA state in the National Grange Photo Contest. The entry must be submitted by a Grange member. The entry may not be from a professional photographer (one who earns a living in the photo industry).
